



CIE Midterm Meeting Vienna 2025 (CIE 2025) Terms & Conditions

Vienna, 26 November 2024

Image Rights

As part of CIE Midterm Meeting Vienna 2025 (CIE 2025), photographs and/or video recordings may be made by or on behalf of the CIE Scientific-Services GmbH. By registering for CIE 2025 (or any part thereof) in the following referred to as CIE events, participants acknowledge that photographs and video material in which they are depicted may be used for reporting and marketing purposes of the CIE Scientific-Services GmbH and the CIE (International Commission on Illumination) as its 100% owner and published across various platforms, including social media, publications, websites and other media and formats.

By attending a CIE event, you agree that you may be identified on CIE recordings and publications. Specifically, the following rights under Austrian law are transferred:

- Reproduction, exhibition, and distribution rights (§§ 16-18 UrhG)
- Broadcasting, lecture, performance, and presentation rights (§§ 19, 20 UrhG)
- Rights of reproduction via audio or visual media (§ 21 UrhG)
- Rights of reproduction of radio broadcasts (§ 22 UrhG)
- Additional rights under § 27 and § 54 UrhG.

If you do not wish to be included in such recordings, you may withdraw your participation or inform the photographer directly.

Furthermore, you may contact the CIE in writing at any time to object to recordings in which you are depicted. Upon receiving your objection, we will modify, delete, or cease further distribution of the images in question.

Registration, Payment and Cancellation Regulations

Registrations to CIE events must be made using the CIE 2025 registration system via the [CIE 2025 website](#). All payments must be wired to the account(s) stated on the CIE 2025 invoices.

The registration system and regular registration procedures will close 14 days ahead of CIE 2025, thus by June 22, 2025. Any registrations thereafter (e.g. on-site) may

require additional documentation (e.g. payment confirmations) from registrants in order to be able to access the conference.

Payments are due within 10 days and must be received on the accounts stated on the invoice(s) by July 3, 2025 at the latest. Access to CIE 2025 will only be granted to registered participants who have settled all dues as owned based on their registration information. On-site payments will be possible. Any open amounts (including from bank charges in the case of bank transfer) must be settled before receiving the name badge and entry allowance to CIE 2025.

If “early” registration fees are not received by May 12, 2025 on the accounts named on the invoice, a new invoice will be issued with the “regular” fee then applicable. If “regular” registration fees are not received by July 3, 2025 on the accounts stated on the invoice(s), a new invoice will be issued with the “on-site” fee.

Your registration for CIE 2025 (and any singular events thereof) is binding and cannot be canceled without following the outlined procedures. Any cancellation must be notified in writing to the registration service at ENITED Business Events GmbH, using the email address: rosa.RM@enited.eu.

In the event of cancellation, the following deadlines and fees apply:

- Cancellation before early-registration deadline (before or on May 1, 2025) – Cancellation fee of 50% of the invoice total, less any transaction charges and administrative charges (handling charge, disagio costs).
- Cancellation after early-registration deadline (after May 1, 2025) – Cancellation fee of 100% of the invoice total (no refund).

Any refunds will only be handled after the closing of CIE 2025. Please be aware that failure to adhere to the current access regulations on the day of the event will not entitle you to a free cancellation or refund of the registration fee.

With your registration, you authorize the organizer to charge any occurring registration and/or cancellation and/or administrative fees to your credit card.

Registrations in special categories:

Participants registering under a reduced fee category (NC members, students, developing country) must be able to prove their status.

NC members will be asked to provide the 2025 CIE discount code applicable to the CIE Webshop for publications. Students will be asked to provide a certificate of registration in a Master’s or PhD programme at the time of registration. Participants from developing countries may be asked to provide a certificate of residence and/or passport information.



If registered participants fail to demonstrate they fall into a specific category, CIE retains the right to cancel the registration and/or issue an invoice in another, applicable price category.

CIE Scientific-Services GmbH has contracted ENITED Business Events GmbH (FN 16 7822 y) to support in the preparation and delivery of CIE 2025, in particular all matters in relation to registration and payments will be handled by ENITED Business Events GmbH.

Handling of Registration Data and Data Protection

Only data necessary for the purpose of organizing CIE 2025 as an official meeting of the International Commission on Illumination is collected, used, stored, and processed.

CIE Scientific-Services GmbH (FN 329027p) and the International Commission on Illumination (CIE) (ZVR 640982399) as well as the contractor ENITED Business Events GmbH are registered in Austria and comply with the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR, 2016).

Regarding the collection and (computerized) processing of your personal data, please note that this is necessary for the organization full implementation of the CIE Midterm Meeting Vienna 2025 (including the publication of Conference Proceedings). Your personal information will only be shared with third parties directly involved in the event organization and only as required for logistical purposes.

CIE 2025 registered participants agree that their data may be used, stored and processed to the extent necessary by the CIE/CIE Scientific-Services for the organization of CIE 2025, the management of membership/participation data in CIE events as well as other immediate purposes linked to CIE 2025 (e.g. publication of basic participant information as submitted to the CIE / CIE Scientific-Services GmbH in programs and publications).

For public purposes and in publications, CIE / CIE Scientific-Services reserves the right to publish full names and affiliations as well as any roles in relation to CIE or CIE 2025 (e.g. Workshop Convenor, Prize Awardee, etc.) of all registered participants to CIE 2025 and singular events thereof (in the case of presenting authors and speakers further information will be published, as submitted to the CIE / CIE Scientific-Services GmbH).

All registration data is stored and hosted on Microsoft Azure, located geographically within the EU (Primary Server Location: Amsterdam, The Netherlands | Backup Server Location: Dublin, Ireland).

Azure is responsible for ensuring the hosting environments' uptime, security, and privacy and provides compliance with relevant international standards and security frameworks, including PCI DSS, ensuring robust safeguards for stored data.

Participant's use of CIE 2025 Conference materials and data

I undertake not to use event materials for commercial purposes, not to copy, not to publish event materials in printed publications, on the Internet, on television, not to distribute them in any other way, including for profit, not to transfer materials received from the Organizer event in paper and electronic form to third parties, including for the purpose of copying and reproduction. If the participant of the event violates the above obligation, the CIE and / or its authorized agent CIE GmbH and / or the Host is entitled to bring the participant of the event to account for this violation and recover from the participant of the event the losses incurred.
